# New Birthing Home Case Statement



Shalom Christian Birthing Clinic, (known locally as *Bahay Paanakan*) takes ACTION's passion for the poor to families by providing quality prenatal care for underprivileged women. The practical assistance of medical care, good health counseling, and delivery services work in concert with spiritual nurturing by local church representatives. The Shalom Birthing Home strategy integrates ongoing discipleship and assimilation into supportive church communities. Stronger families with quality midwifery protection—cared for practically, emotionally, and spiritually—helps to strengthen the Filipino family and keep those children off the streets.

## Shalom's History

Shalom was started by ACTION missionary Mavis Orton. Mavis is a nurse and midwife from England, who came to the Philippines in 1986. As she observed the high mortality rate among women giving birth and their newborns, a vision was born to develop a place where good maternity care could be available for those living in poverty. In January 1992, Shalom Christian Birthing Home was started in Mavis' home.

ACTION missionary and nurse Cindy Gingerich joined Mavis in 2002. What makes Shalom distinct from other birthing homes is that each patient hears the Gospel and is prayed for by Mavis' team. The birthing home now has a good team of missionaries, midwives and nurses. A nearby church works closely with Shalom's staff and has seen many trust Christ who are now actively involved in church.

Mavis received the distinguished award of "Member of the British Empire" from Queen Elizabeth II, Queen of England in 2007 for her outstanding ministry among the poor. Imagine this grass roots ministry catching the attention of the Queen of England!



## Shalom's Surroundings

The Birthing Home is located in Antipolo, Rizal, 29 kilometers east of Manila. Shalom is surrounded by several squatter communities, home to thousands of men, women, and children. The average income for the families in these communities is 250 pesos (\$5 US) per day, when they have work. Although there are a few private hospitals nearby, the people in these communities cannot afford the medical care they provide. The women that come to Shalom are able to receive pre-natal and delivery care in a safe and sanitary environment that they otherwise would not receive.

## Shalom's Ministry

This valuable ministry has great impact. Each week, 300 mothers, on average, avail themselves of regular checkups at Shalom. During this time, local pastors minister the gospel through Bible study. Not only are physical needs met, but a spiritual foundation is laid that will prayerfully effect generations to come.

## Shalom Today

Shalom's present facilities are over-crowded and threaten to turn needy women away. When the birthing home first opened, eight babies were born a month, now approximately 150 babies are born monthly. Shalom has limited space with only 2 rooms for pre-and post-natal check-ups and deliveries. So after much prayer and planning, ACTION started a project to build a larger facility to provide rooms for check-ups, deliveries, classrooms, laundry, waste disposal and record keeping.

## Shalom's future

ACTION is trusting the Lord to be able to build a new clinic in 2009. The land next to the current clinic was purchased in 2006. Now a perimeter wall has been erected, and the foundation is being laid. Blueprints are ready and permits have been obtained. The building is being constructed in three phases, as funds are available on a no-debt policy.

Phase I Ground preparation, foundation, infrastructure, laundry room, waste disposal area and main level examination and birthing rooms

Phase II Main level reception area and offices

Phase III Upper level classroom, additional offices and dormitory
